Goals:

1. Create a Link on the Parish Website – “Get Involved”

Target Date: 01 October 2011

Details: Inquirer clicks on the Link and list Name & Email Address and Checks off Categories of Interest (Events, Groups, Ministries, Retreats). Inquirer’s name is forwarded (by Link Coordinator - Staff Member or Lay Volunteer) to Directors (YC, Youth, Outreach, Spirituality). Directors provide email updates of upcoming Events.

2. Establish “Young Adult Organization”

Target Dates: 07 June 2011 (Meet Young Adult Leaders to form 1st Young Adult Leadership Brd)

09 August 2011 (Finalize ‘11/’12 Schedule, Have Minimum of 100 Member/email)

December 2011 (Major Service Event)

May 2012 (1st Annual Young Adult / College Mass)

Summer 2012 (Three Sunday Night Young Adult Events)

Summer 2012 (Major Young Adult / Sharing Parish Youth Event)

Details: The Young Adult Organization will have Oversight from a Clergy Advisor and a Volunteer Lay Director (two year term). The Young Adult Leadership Board will Develop Annual Programs. Major Service Event TBD. Sunday Night Events could include Speakers, Discussion Groups, Book Club, etc. Major Young Adult Sharing Parish Youth Event could be Olympics, Soccer Tournament, etc. followed by Mass then BBQ/Dance (this event would be run by our Young Adult Org with kids from SJC and Sharing Parishes as the Guest).

3. Provide a Site Map on the Parish Website to assist all Parishioner where Offices and Services exist within our Campus.

Target Date: 07 June 2011

4. Establish a New Parishioners Mentoring Program

Target Date 30 June 2011

Details: New Parishioners will be assigned a mentor (from a list of volunteers). The mentor will contact the New Parishioner within two weeks. The mentor will coordinate a meeting with the New Parishioners' Group (Ginny Grecco/Jane Sanchez). An ongoing relationship will be maintained by the Mentor to assist the New Parishioner to navigate through all of the Parish Organizations (school, YC, spiritual growth, volunteer opportunities) available at SJC.

5. Co-Sponsor the New Mom's group "Circle of Friends"

Target Date 10 May 2011

Details: New Group started and funded by the SJC Women's Club. They have focused on reaching out to new mothers to help them meet other women (families) that are in the same stage of life. Some of the strongest bonds that women make are with those women that they met while their children were just babies. This group will meet once a month to start and come together in faith and friendship. With current membership of 40 (moms and children) and the expectations that this number will increase the Women's Club is seeking a Co-Sponsorship from the Parish (\$600 Parish donation per year to match the Mother's Club donation).
